

## PreCalculus for Credit at Renaissance School - Summer 2024

***Get ahead, catch up, or make up this foundation for Calculus!***

<b>What:</b>	A full year of Honors PreCalculus in four weeks, for credit

Summer is a great time for focused learning in a small class setting! Join us this summer to get ahead - or catch up - in math. We will be covering all key content for the honors level of PreCalculus, including:

- Trigonometry
- Higher level polynomial functions
- Logarithmic and exponential functions
- Conic sections

Advanced students may add PreCalculus to the Algebra II course for no additional fee. For Renaissance students, PreCalculus may be taken in lieu of Integrated Math III. The course is taught by Bethany Farris, CFA. Ms. Farris is the Renaissance School Dean of Academics, where she has taught all levels of high school math for over 10 years. Prior to joining RS, she enjoyed work in various fields, including research with NASA and investment consulting in London and Madrid. Former parents and students say:

The class is structured to maximize class time to minimize homework. Required materials for the class are:

- Graphing paper & lined paper
- Binder
- Pencils (colored pencils or pens optional)
- TI-82 or similar graphing calculator

**Registration for the PreCalculus summer session at Renaissance School is open.** Combined class size with Algebra II is limited to 14 students and spots are assigned on a first-come, first-served basis, so register early to ensure your place. A minimum enrollment of 4 students is required for the class to proceed.
